Dear Parents and Students

We are very much looking forward to seeing students on results day to celebrate their results and to congratulate them on their hard work and success.

Arrangements for Results Day

This year GCSE results day is **Thursday 25 August**. Students will be able to receive their results in one of the following ways:

1. Students can collect results in person from the drama hall. We are staggering collection as below:

9.00 - 9.20	Students' surnames A – H
9.30 - 9.50	Students' surnames I – O
10.00 - 10.20	Students' surnames P – Z

2. Parents can collect results from reception after 9am on Thursday 25 August. Students should contact exams@klbschool.org.uk before Thursday 11 August to give permission for a named parent to collect results. Parents should come into reception through the school's main entrance.

Results day is an exciting but also anxious time; please be assured that there will be a number of staff around to support students as they collect results. Parents are welcome to wait in the car park while students collect results. We will encourage students to come straight back to you, we know you will be anxious and excited too!

- 3. We can email results to students at 10.30am on Thursday 25 August. If students would like their results emailed, they should notify exams@klbschool.org.uk before Thursday 11 August. Please note that emails will only be sent to students' school email accounts.
- 4. Results not collected on Thursday 25 August, will be posted home to students on Friday 26 August. It will not be possible to provide results on the telephone.

Guidance and Support

A range of staff will be on hand to offer support and guidance, including Mr Pegg (Head of Careers), year 11 tutors, members of the KLB Sixth Form Team and also senior staff.

KLB Sixth Form Applications

For the students who have applied to KLB Sixth Form, a letter will be enclosed inside the GCSE results envelope. This will confirm the status of each student's application. If all entry requirements have been met, the letter will confirm the courses. If a student has not secured the grades for one or more subjects, we will have considered the student's historical data and consulted with relevant teachers before reaching a decision.

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Students are welcome to talk to members of the sixth form team to consider alternatives. This will depend on grade requirements, the option blocks and the numbers in classes. This will be explained in the letter.

We will reserve a place in the sixth form for all successful applicants for 5 days. To confirm acceptance of the offer, students should email <u>hkhan@klbschool.org.uk</u> before 5pm on Wednesday 31 August. I will acknowledge all emails.

For students who have not met the entry requirements to join the sixth form, Mr Pegg will be happy to support.
