Geoffrey Harper (A\*AA D2) is taking up a place at Guildhall School of Music and Drama to study Music Composition.

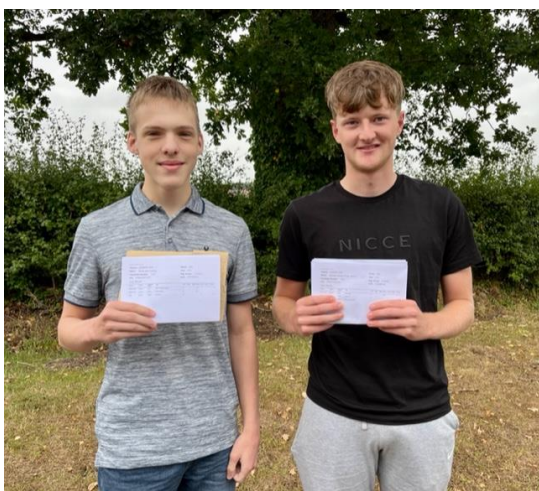
