


PROGRESS IS THE HIGHEST IN THE COUNTRY (ALPS 2022/23)

For many years, national progress measures place KLB Sixth Form amongst the **top schools in the country.** Whilst the 2022 and 2023 16-18 DfE Performance Tables have not included progress measures (due to Covid disruption), many schools continue to use the Alps system to measure the progress made by students. This uses the strong correlation between average GCSE performance and A level results. This year, the overarching Alps progress measure which incorporates all individual progress measures over the past three years, has placed KLB Sixth Form in the top percentile of centres nationally.

Teaching

Careers Advice

In our most recent Ofsted report, inspectors made the following comments about teaching and the curriculum in the Sixth Form: 'Students enjoy their courses and respond well to the teaching they receive.' 'Teaching strikes the right balance between support and challenge for students. They are encouraged to think for themselves, develop powers of argument and learn how to interrogate ideas and challenge hypotheses. When students need help, staff provide them with the personalised attention that moves them forward. These relationships with staff are highly valued.' 'Students follow personalised study programmes that meet their needs and interests.'

In these final years at school, our students will make critical choices about their future. Many will be aiming for university and will need guidance in choosing the most appropriate courses based on their interests, strengths and, in some cases, their career aspirations. Some students will be making the difficult choice as to whether they should move straight from Year 13 to Higher Education, while others will be thinking of moving on to apprenticeships or other work based training routes. In all cases we will provide support to help the students with their decision making.

Higher Education

Most of our students apply for Higher Education and will be competing against the best from other state and independent schools. Our Higher Education consultant and Sixth Form team aim to offer students the best possible support, whether it's choosing the right courses, crafting a UCAS personal statement that will stand out from the rest or preparing for that all-important interview. We take great pride in seeing our students do well, with many gaining places on the most competitive degree courses in the country.
