Studying Religious Education at KLB is to explore what different people believe and what difference this makes to how they live, so that pupils can gain the knowledge, understanding and skills needed to handle questions raised by religion, belief, and worldviews reflecting on their own ideas and ways of living.

The RE curriculum builds and develop upon the knowledge gained from KS2, and prepares students for the challenge and rigour of KS4 and beyond.

The three types of knowledge that the curriculum aims to develop are;

- 1. Substantive knowledge (the key beliefs and facts about religions)
- 2. Ways of knowing (how we go about studying aspect of RE)
- 3. Personal knowledge (how this new learning impacts upon me as an individual).

The RE curriculum at KS3 focusses on understanding aspects of Christianity, Buddhism, Islam and Sikhi as well as Humanism and other world views.
